SCHEME OF ASSESSMENT OF STUDENTS PERFORMANCE

The performance of student in BACHELOR OF ARTS (BA) is assessed under Numerical Marking Scheme Evaluation Methodology has the following two components for Theory course:

- (i) Continuous Evaluation through Assignment and (ii) Term-end Examination.

In Theory courses, Continuous Evaluation carries 30% weightage and Term-end Examination carries 70% weightage

MINIMUM STANDARD FOR COMPLETION OF A COURSE AND PROGRAMME

Minimum 35% marks for continuous evaluation and 35% for Term-end examination are required separately with overall 35% marks. 96 credits are required to qualify for the award of Bachelor's Degree in Arts

Student should earn 24 credits of Foundation Courses, 58/64 Credits of Elective Courses and 8/16 credits of Applied or Oriented Courses

The courses worth 40 out of total 96 credits in a particular discipline are required to be completed to get Major Degree except in Mathematics discipline. For Major in Mathematics, 40 out of total 96 credits are required
