



1. Total number of chances is five (1 +4).
2. Minimum number of marks required to pass the examination are 33% in each subject (separately in written and practical).
3. A candidate who fails in one or more subjects by 5 marks or less is declared pass by awarding grace marks.
4. A candidate who misses 1st or 2nd Division by 5 marks or less (if he/she has not availed subject grace) is awarded grace up to 5 marks.
5. Second annual exam is open for fresh candidates as well as compartment/failed as a whole candidates.
6. The candidate failing in one or two or more subjects will have to reappear only in the subjects in which he/she has failed. He/she will not have to reappear in all the subjects.
7. The candidates of special categories (Doctor, Nurse, Fazil, Wafq-ul-Madaris & Additional Subjects etc.) have to pass the whole examination in single attempt. No grace marks are available for these candidates.
8. The candidate desiring to improve division is given only one chance within one year of passing the exam. Such a candidate cannot change subject.

B.Com

1. Total number of chances is four (1+3).
2. Minimum number of marks required to pass the examination are 40% in each paper.
3. A candidate who fails in only one paper by 5 marks or less is declared pass by awarding grace marks at one time.
4. A candidate who misses 1st or 2nd Division by 5 marks or less (provided he/she has not availed subject grace) is awarded grace up to 5 marks.
5. A candidate who passes at least 6 papers of Part I is allowed to appear in Part II. However, if a candidate fails in any of the papers of Part-I exam in prescribed chances failing which the result of Part-II will also be automatically quashed/cancelled.
6. Second Annual Examination is open for fresh and compartment/failed as a whole candidate.
7. Only a candidate who obtains 3rd division is given two chances to improve division.

4. A candidate who misses 1st Division by 5 marks or less (if he/she has not availed subject/aggregate grace) is awarded grace up to 5 marks.
5. The candidate who passes 50% of his/her first appearance in Part-I or Part-II (once either in Part-I or Part-II) is declared pass by awarding grace marks provided he has taken the exam in all subjects. If a candidate fails in any of the papers of Part-I exam in prescribed chances failing which result of Part II will also be automatically quashed/cancelled.
6. The candidate failing in 50% or more subjects is declared totally fail and he/she will have to appear in all subject in next Examination.
7. The candidate desiring to improve division in Part-I or Part II or Part-I & II together or composite examination is given two chances within one year of passing the examination. Moreover, a candidate who has passed composite exam is required to appear in all subject in next examination.
8. Second annual examination is open for fresh and compartment/failed as whole candidates.
