NOTE: Pass/Fail Grade Agreement

To receive a P/F grade in any elective, students must obtain a signed approval from the Instructor and submit to the Registrar within the first four weeks of the semester. Pass/Fail agreement forms may be obtained in the Registrar's Office. A student may not complete more than 6 credits with a P grade within the first 60 credits, and no more than 12 credits with a P grade within the total baccalaureate program. A student may not take a course on a Pass/Fail within the College-wide Core Curriculum without the approval of the Provost. A Pass/Fail grade may not be requested within the major without the approval of the Departmental Chairperson who may also limit the number of Pass/Fail courses taken.
