Swinburne Grade Point Average Equivalencies for Malaysian Students

As part of the student academic performance measurement process, Swinburne uses a Grade Point Average (GPA) system. GPA is a simple numerical index summarising student academic performance in a course. A GPA can be used for numerous purposes such as identifying candidates for academic prizes, as a measure of academic achievement when applying for a job or included in the selection criteria for admission to another university place.

The two main GPA scales are the 4-point and 7-point scale, which differ by the grade points allocated but share the same calculation method. Swinburne has used the 4-point scale since 2014. GPA is displayed with student results and appears on academic transcripts.

Even though students are awarded GPA via a 4-point rating scale, there are differences in application of the GPA values both in Australia and Malaysia. The following table outlines how Swinburne grades, GPA scale are in comparison to Malaysian GPA scale.
