

THE EXAMINATION

The **Indian School Certificate (Class-XII) Examination** is in accordance with the 10 plus 2 scheme of school education of the Kothari Education Commission and is taken after a 2-year course of study beyond the **Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (Class-X) Examination** or its equivalent.

I. EXTERNAL EXAMINATION :

Attainment in a subject is indicated by a percentage mark.

II. INTERNAL ASSESSMENT :

The standard attained in Socially Useful Productive Work and Community Service, abbreviated on the face of the Statement of Marks as SUPW and COMMUNITY SERVICE, is indicated by a letter grade, of which Grade A is the highest and Grade E the lowest. The interpretation of the grades is as follows :

Provided that no candidate, except as otherwise exempted by the CISCE, shall be awarded a Pass Certificate unless in addition to fulfilling the conditions above, the candidate has attained a pass grade in SUPW and COMMUNITY SERVICE as examined / assessed internally by the School.
