For a Semester:

For the entire Programme:

CGPA is applicable only for the successful candidates.

CGPA = Sum of the multiplication of grade points by the credits of the entire programme

Sum of the credits of the courses for the entire programme

Ci = Credit earned for the course i in any semester.

Gi = Grade point obtained for the course i in any semester.

n refers to the semester in which such courses were credited.
