## Grading System : Conversion of Percentage of Marks into Grade Points

### Award of Grades based on Absolute Marks



Range of Marks	Letter Grade	Grade Point
90-100	A+	9 < 10

50-59	D	5 < 5.9
00-49	F	< 4.9
Absent	Ab	0

Letter Grades : A+, A, B, C and D denotes successful completion of the course.

The letter Grade 'F' denotes failed in the course and requires for reappearance in the examination.

The letter Grade 'Ab' denotes the student's non-appearance in the examination.

#### For a Semester :

$$\text{GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)} = \left( \sum_i C_i G_i / \sum_i C_i \right)$$

$$\text{GPA} = \frac{\text{Sum of the multiplication of grade points by the credits of the courses}}{\text{Sum of the credits of the courses in a semester}}$$

#### For the entire Programme :

$$\text{CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE (CGPA)} = \left( \sum_n \sum_i C_{ni} G_{ni} / \sum_n \sum_i C_{ni} \right)$$

CGPA is applicable only for the successful candidates.

$$\text{CGPA} = \frac{\text{Sum of the multiplication of grade points by the credits of the entire programme}}{\text{Sum of the credits of the courses for the entire programme}}$$

$C_i$  = Credit earned for the course  $i$  in any semester.

$G_i$  = Grade point obtained for the course  $i$  in any semester.

$n$  refers to the semester in which such courses were credited.

### Classification of Successful Candidates

Students who could not complete the programme of study within the duration of the course. (i.e. within the 4 semesters) and clears the arrears within the next three academic years.	50% and above (irrespective of the percentage of marks)	Second Class
