KEY

Levels: At the University of Gloucestershire Levels I, II and III are the equivalent of work undertaken by a full-time student in the first, second and third years respectively of an undergraduate programme. They equate to Levels 4, 5 and 6 in the National Qualifications Framework.

A postgraduate student undertakes study at Level IV which equates to Level 7 of the National Qualifications Framework.

Credit: Each module has a credit value (Credit Accumulation and Transfer (CAT) points). These can translate into ECTS credit values by dividing the CAT credit value by two. Approximately 10 hours of total student study time is required per CAT credit, and a full-time academic year (or equivalent) equates to 120 CATs for undergraduates and 180 CATs for postgraduates.

Grading and Marking scheme: For most modules, marks are awarded on the scale 0-100%. Some are marked on a Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory basis. The following grades and marks can appear on a final transcript:





EXPLANATORY NOTES

Transcript policy

Until 1962 all universities in New Zealand were constituent colleges of the University of New Zealand. From 1963 they have been autonomous institutions, but it is still common practice for a New Zealand university student to transfer to another university within New Zealand, even while pursuing a degree. The official academic record of a university student in New Zealand transferred with the student up until 1997. Since 1998 academic records have not been transferred. Students now are responsible for getting a copy of their academic record from each of the universities they have attended.

Undergraduate degree structure

Victoria University adopted a credit system for the BA, BCA and BMus degrees in 1972, and for the BSc degree in 1973. Before this the undergraduate courses were taught in units at Stage I (first year), Stage II (second year) and Stage III (third year). The LLB degree was taught in "subjects" up until 1991, after which credit values were shown. From 1998 onwards Victoria has adopted a points system, with 120 points equating to an average full-time year of study.

Course identifiers

Courses are identified by a four letter subject code and a three digit number. The four letters represent either a school or a subject area. A full list of subject codes is available on the University website <http://www.victoria.ac.nz/home/study/subjects/subjectandcodes.aspx> or in the University Calendar.

The first digit represents the level of the course. The 000-level range is used for pre-degree level courses; 100-level courses are first-year or introductory courses; 200-level and 300-level courses represent advanced undergraduate courses; Honours and Master's courses are 400- and 500-level; PhD courses are 600-level, and the 800-level range is used for Diploma courses. From 2003, courses are no longer attributed to qualifications.


