- For pass in examination a candidate is required to obtain atleast 25% marks in each paper and 36% marks in the total aggregate in theory at the every semester examination separately and 36% marks in practical separately.
- Theory - I<sup>st</sup> Division- 60% and above, II<sup>nd</sup> Division-48% to below 60%, Pass Class-36% to below 48%.
- (a) A candidate who has failed at I & II Semester Examination but has passed in atleast 50% of the papers prescribed for the papers prescribed for the examination obtaining 25% Marks in each paper in accordance with the rules given below shall be eligible to reappear in the failing papers of III & IV Semester respectively.  
 (b) A candidate who has failed at the III & IV semester examination but has passed in atleast 50% of the papers obtaining 25% marks in each paper prescribed for the examination in accordance with the rules given in the clause below shall be exempted from re-appearing in a subsequent year in the papers in which he has passed.  
 (i) Where the candidate fails in securing the requisite minimum percentage of marks prescribed for a pass in the aggregate of all the papers, he shall be deemed to have passed in each such papers in which he has secured atleast 25% marks.  
 (ii) for reckoning 50% of the papers at the semester examinations, practical will be included and one practical will be counted as one paper.  
 (iii) If the number of papers prescribed for the I, II, III & IV Semesters Examination is an odd number, it shall be increased by one of the purpose of reckoning 50% of the papers.
- (a) A candidate who does not pass even in 50% of the papers prescribed for the Sem. Examination in accordance with the above rules shall not be eligible for admission to the next semester. He will be required to re-appear at the failed semester in all the prescribed papers & practicals.  
 (b) A candidate who does not pass even in 50% of the papers prescribed for the Sem. III & IV Examination in accordance with the above rules shall be required to re-appear at the same in subsequent III & IV Semester in all the prescribed papers & Practical.
- If a candidate clears any papers / practical/dissertation / via-vio prescribed at the I, II, III & IV Semester separately after a continuous period of two years, for the purpose of working out his division, only the minimum pass marks viz. 25% (36% in case of practical) shall be taken into account in respect of such papers/ practical/dissertation / via-vio as are cleared after the aforesaid period provided that in case where a candidate required more than 25% marks in order to reach in requisite minimum aggregate as many marks out of these actually secured by him will be taken into account as would enable him to make up deficiency in the requisite minimum aggregate.
- Marks written with asterisk (\*) against a paper that denotes failure in that paper.
- All court cases shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Jaipur and not entertained at any other place.
