Provided that no candidate, except as otherwise exempted by CISCE, shall be awarded a Pass Certificate Cum Statement of Marks unless in addition to fulfilling the conditions above, the candidate has attained a pass grade (A - D) in SUPW and COMMUNITY SERVICE as examined/assessed internally by the school.

Statement of Marks will be issued to the candidates whose Result is declared as Not Qualified.

Supplementary Statement of Marks will be issued to candidates who appear in a subsequent examination in one or more subjects.
